

A new Gallup poll that is very good news for Donald Trump.

**The polls can change quickly and we need to campaign hard for Trump no matter what any poll says.**

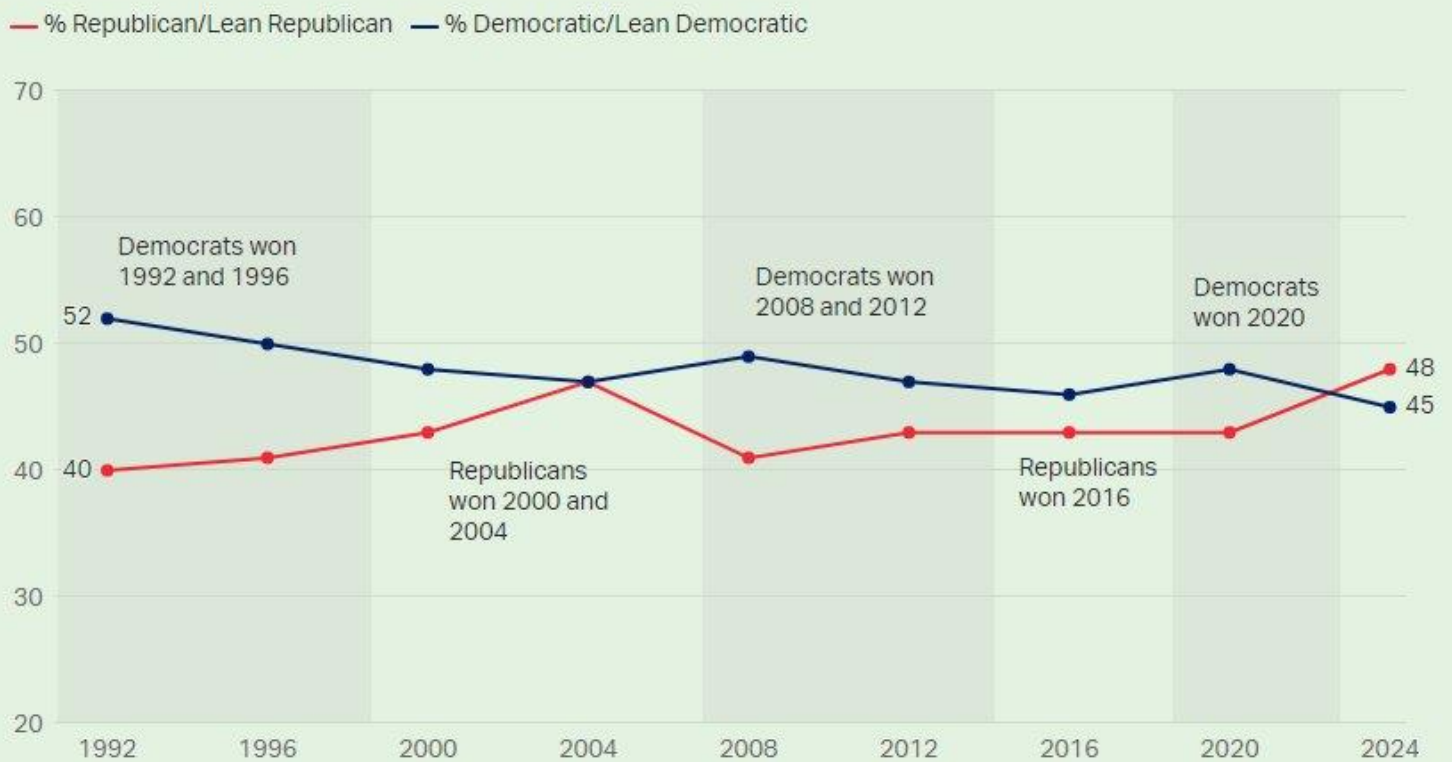
But this one is encouraging.

The electoral college count is what decides who wins the presidency. But at the highest levels of prediction, there are the polls about who will win the national popular vote.

Here is the latest Gallup poll.

## U.S. Adults' Party Identification and Leaning in Presidential Election Years

Figures are the average party identification and leaning in the third quarter (July-September) of each election year

You can see the Democrats have had the advantage for many years.

But for 2024 in the July-September quarter, Gallup estimates the national party leaning is Republican + 3.

This is huge. **If** the national voters are truly leaning R+3, it is almost certain that Trump will win the electoral vote.

When people publish polls, they weigh the results by what they think the leaning is. Most polls today assume the overall population is D+3.

If R+3 is true, that points to Trump winning the national popular vote and the Electoral College.

Remember, this can change over the next few weeks. But for today, we know we are in a tough fight that can be won.

From a CNN survey:

“Kamala Harris has a major problem – it’s Joe Biden, and the fact she’s his Vice President. In our CNN survey yesterday, 51% of registered voters said that Trump had a successful presidency, only 37% said the same about Biden and Harris.
